A revised edition of a convenient and user-friendly handbook aimed at trainees in gastroenterology and general medicine. Combining the advantages of a colour atlas with those of a short text, the authors provide systematic coverage of the diseases and disorders of the digestive tract. Each condition is described and illustrated on a single page or spread of pages. The first edition of the book was praised for its compact approach and high quality illustrations including colour photos, imaging and diagrams. The new second edition covers the latest developments in investigation and management, and includes over 200 new illustrations, mainly reflecting refinements in endoscopy and other imaging techniques.
